

WHAT TYPE OF RETRACTOR DO YOU HAVE?

YOU CAN EASILY TELL BY YOUR SEAT BELT'S TONGUE.
THE TONGUE IS WHAT CLICKS INTO THE BUCKLE



Single Retractor

- All modern vehicles (newer than ~2000) have single retractor tongues
- A single retractor tongue typically does not have the webbing sewn to it.
- Instead, the webbing typically flows through a single retractor tongue.



In the rare instance where the webbing is sewn to a single retractor tongue, you will only ever see 1 piece of webbing sewn to it.

Dual Retractor

- Dual retractor tongues were used on some cars during roughly 1974-2000
- A dual retractor tongue has 2 separate or independent pieces of webbing sewn to it
